Position Title: Welder

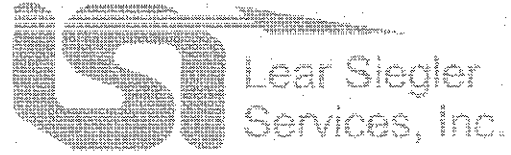
Qualifications & Competencies:

This is a position with a physical rating of heavy. Must have a minimum of three (3) years experience in welding. Experience in fabrication and production a plus. Should have experience in the Army 44-B Series MOS or equivalent. All branches of service are encouraged to apply. Must have a U.S. passport. Must be able to pass a physical exam due to the harsh living and working conditions. Must also pass a pre-employment criminal background check and drug screen. This is a one (1) year assignment.
